Teachers College Columbia	Innovation; interdisciplinary collaboration; expanded international research, external funding	All travel stopped until further notice Implementation shifted online or delayed Expanded guidance to help faculty with online shift and researchers on the ground
Long Island University	Research/external funding or impact made possible <u>only</u> with international partner	Delayed implementation OK, Alternative (distance) OK, only if same objectives can be met
UC Davis	Facilitating int'l partnerships; building research capacity; supporting interdisciplinary work on campus; funding	Grant extensions Flexibility with activities New grants continue to be awarded this year—new curricular grants on hold
UT Knoxville	Building int'l research capacity; funding	Grant extensions; Allowing int'l travel for faculty; Flexibility with activities
